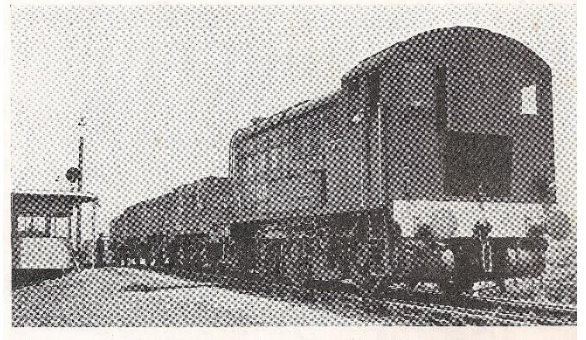


Source 4: Downside Shunting Records July 1939



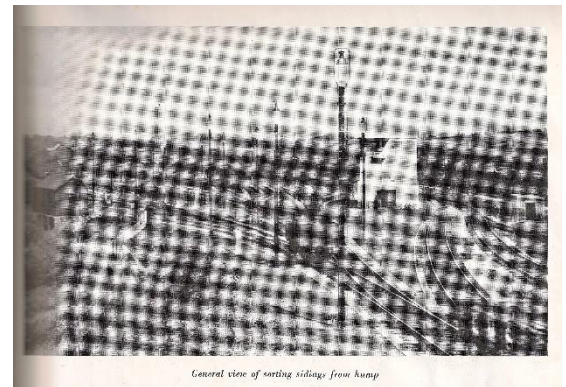
- 1. What time did the train from Kettering arrive at Toton?
